



The Clan Davidson Room at Tulloch Castle



The Clan Davidson Room at Tulloch Castle, Dingwall was formally opened by the Clan Davidson Association President, Lord Davidson of Glen Clova, and local Councillor Margaret Paterson on 29 September 2007.

The Room was converted from a former derelict store room and now provides an interesting and attractive display of Davidson history and genealogical information using pictures, books, posters, and artifacts such as Davidson glass and china.

Tulloch Castle was the ancestral home of Chiefs of the Clan Davidson, and the current owners, Oxford Hotels & Inns, have fully supported the creation of this information centre, which is open to visitors to the hotel.

The collection of items in the Clan Davidson Room continues to grow with new information and artefacts sent in from around the world. For anyone wanting to know more about their wider Davidson family history, the Clan Davidson Room is an important focal point.
