

Arms of Australian Davidsons at the Lyon Court, Edinburgh

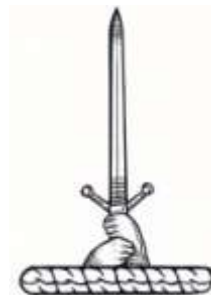
Vol 28. 77 Euphemia Jane Woolrabe [nee Davidson]

Azure on a fess Argent between two pheons in chief Or, armed and langued Gules, a stag couchant of the last attired Sable, all set in a lozenge

Crest: Two hands holding a claymore erect in pale Proper

Motto: Byde the Brunt

Both Euphemia and Marion were daughters of Walter Davidson of Riccarton near Meadowbank and Camelford, near Campbeltown, Tasmania.



Frederick William Woolrabe, member of the same family incorporated, these arms into his own.
